To visualise an individual system with the VBus®Touch, a RESOL controller with a VBus® interface and a data logger are required. To enable worldwide system access, the data logger simply requires a connection to the Internet.

Access data for two RESOL test systems are provided with the software, allowing the user to try out VBus®Touch right away. The basic version of the new VBus®Touch app is available free-of-charge in the App Store. Extended features will be available as modular add-ons (that the user can individually combine and install via the integrated update function). The RESOL app is also compatible with the Apple products iPhone and the iPod touch.
